SUMMARY:

T.G.C Surveillance Technicians are responsible for the upkeep of Chukchansi Gold Resort and Casino’s state of the art closed circuit television (CCTV) system. This involves but not limited to the installation of various low-voltage equipment such as Cameras, Alarms, Linux and Windows based Enterprise Class Storage Servers, Company Computers, Network Switches, and Bio-Metrics equipment. Technicians will be responsible for various projects assigned by upper management. Physical demand for the job is about 80/20 80% of the time will be physical work 20% of the time will be office work. Must be able to lift an average of 50lbs frequently, work off of ladders and man lifts, work in dusty, dark, hot, cold and smoky (tobacco smoke) areas for long periods of time.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following:

- Installs and maintains/repair all equipment related to the Tribal Gaming Commission CCTV Infrastructure.
- Maintains a working knowledge of all rules and regulations of the Gaming Commission, and ensures strict adherence to these procedures throughout the property.
- Implements preventative maintenance programs designed to eliminate system failures.
- Pull and terminate various types of data cabling and installation of conduit.
- Routinely inspects power supplies, wiring, and equipment on property, identifying and correcting any potential problems.
- Ensures that inventory of equipment and supplies is accurately kept at all times.
- Consults with management and vendors on specific types of equipment needed for certain surveillance operations and projects.
- Facilitates the flow of information throughout the department, by attending regularly scheduled departmental meetings.
- Maintains a consistent and regular attendance record.
- Held accountable for the accuracy and thoroughness of departmental records and reports.
- Prepares temporary surveillance coverage as needed.
