CGRC is seeking enrolled Chukchansi Members interested in exploring employment opportunities with CGRC. This internship is ideal for Tribal Members who are interested in working at CGRC but may not be certain about which position or department to pursue.

Interns select either Track 1, 2, 3, or 4 to work during their internship based on their career goals and interests. Interns will rotate through various departments within each track. The rotation will provide interns with a clearer understanding of department operations to highlight or confirm career interests.

Program Features:

- Career Introduction Internships provide interns the opportunity to learn job-related skills as they explore and choose a specific career path.
- Interns will learn or enhance: professional communication skills, team work, guest service, and specific job duties by successfully completing assigned job duties and learning assignments within the chosen internship track.
- Interns work 20-29 hours per week at the normal Tribal Team Member rate of pay.

Basic Requirements:

- Interns must be willing to commit to 26 weeks of work/study; be able to work a flexible schedule (days, swing, grave, weekends, holidays); and be committed to investing in their career development. Interns may elect out of the internship program if regular employment becomes available.
- Proof of membership with the Picayune Rancheria of Chukchansi Indians is required.
- High School diploma/GED or be willing to pursue as part of the internship. Trade certificates and college degrees a plus.
