### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS:**

### **CONSULTANT TO ADVISE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TRIBAL PRESCHOOL**

JULY 31, 2019

The Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians (PRCI), a federally recognized sovereign Indian tribe, requests proposals for a consultant to develop a tribal preschool program that incorporates teaching Chukchansi language.

The consultant will be tasked with producing the following documents:

- Sample budget for start-up and annual preschool funding.
- A report on the action steps required to establish the preschool and all required or recommended licensing/accreditation.
- Draft policies for the operation of the tribal preschool.
- Draft operation plan including staffing required, space and equipment recommendations.

All RFP responses must be signed and must include the following:

1. A summary of your experience in Preschool development and/or administration;
2. A summary of your experience in and familiarity with Tribal communities and issues;
3. Timeline on meeting the deliverables and milestones of this project;
4. A statement of proposed fees and costs;

PRCI exercises Native American preference in contracting. You are encouraged to

include any information in your response that would qualify you for Native American preference. The selected individual/firm will be expected to sign a retainer letter that recognizes the sovereignty of PRCI.

PRCI reserves the right to award or reject any response or proposal for any reason, to request modification of any proposal, or to solicit further proposals, or to determine not to pursue further action, as may become necessary in the best interest of PRCI.
