**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS:
Indian Health Care Consultant**

June 25, 2020

The Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians (PRCI), a federally recognized Indian tribe requests proposals for an Indian health care consultant.

All RFP responses must be signed by an authorized representative of your firm, and must include the following:

1. A summary of your firm's experience and results in providing consulting services for the establishment and operation of tribal health facilities under the Indian Health Care Improvement Act and the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act. The summary should include your specific experience in maximizing funding streams for Indian health care providers, including third party resources;
2. A summary of your firm's experience in and familiarity with tribal communities and issues;
3. A summary of your proposed project team with resumes for each member; and
4. A statement of proposed fees and costs.

Preference is given first to Tribal Members and then to other Native Americans. You are encouraged to include any information in your response that would qualify you for preference. The selected individual/firm will be expected to sign a retainer letter that recognizes the sovereignty of PRCI.

PRCI reserves the right to award or reject any response or proposal for any reason, to request modification of any proposal, or to solicit further proposals, or to determine not to pursue further action, as may become necessary in the best interest of PRCI.
