Re: COVID-19 and Cancellation of Business Meeting

Dear Tribal Members:

Due to the current spike in COVID-19 cases, the Tribal Council Business Meeting scheduled for Thursday, November 19, 2020, has been cancelled to protect the health and safety of Tribal Members.

Nationwide, COVID-19 cases are rising, with the State of California now having over a million confirmed cases of COVID-19.¹ As of November 17, 2020, Madera County has 526 confirmed active COVID-19 cases² and is considered by the State of California as experiencing widespread transmission of COVID-19.³ Additionally, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention still considers medium or larger-sized in-person gatherings to present a high risk for community transmission.⁴
